
# URBAN DRILLING: OUR PROBLEM JUST GOT WORSE

#### **WHAT TO EXPECT**

The 3 controversial wells already proposed are exploratory. If the wells produce, Goldenkey is poised to expand the project with many more wells, associated pipelines, processing and storage facilities and all the risks associated with them.

- 2. **REFUND** Goldenkey Oil Inc. the \$500,000 license fee paid to the Alberta Government.
- 3. **DECLARE** a permanent moratorium on oil/gas drilling within the municipal boundaries of the City of Lethbridge.
